<b>Action 1:</b> Conducting 4 stop days per year to check on ELA pacing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We will use this data to support teams who are falling behind to help them with pacing and instruction.</li></ul>
<b>Action 2:</b> Additional ELA Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We have condensed staff meetings to provide additional plan time on Wednesdays</li><li>• We have found SEL instructors so that staff get an extra 30 min of plan each month during SEL time.</li></ul>
<b>Action 3:</b> Instructional Coaching Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• IC is joining teams once per week to focus on ELA instruction.</li><li>• Each grade level has an assigned ELA coach that they meet with on Wednesday after school.</li><li>• ELA coaches meet bi-weekly to debrief about what each team is doing and share ideas.</li></ul>
