- I. Welcome
 - As directed by President Russell Johnston, participants attending introduced themselves.
- **II.** Principal's Report (Stephanie Hornung)

 - Stephanie detailed one grants given for students to use a button maker in art.

 - The next Dining Night Out will be in partnership with Lighthouse Pizza. More details will be provided when an actual date has been scheduled.
 - Box Tops will be re-launched for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - The Ice Cream Social will not happen this school year due to safety concerns surrounding the pandemic.
 LCC members will work with Stephanie to come up with other "perks" that can be provided to students through the end of the year.
