







Family Resource Center



Goals & Enhancements

- Provide a dedicated Family Resource Center on the Westside High School Campus to serve High School students (38% District wide) in need.
- The new resource center would not only provide an accessible and robust resource for disadvantaged students and families, but it will also provide service-learning opportunities to all students.
- This resource center will include a clothing closet, food pantry, and the Westside Community School Social Work services - which will be available to all Westside Community School families.
- It is imperative for the District to provide accessible services to students and families to eliminate barriers that oftentimes impact student academic performance.
- Similar to the student-run Colosseum (Westside apparel and merchandise), the Family Resource Center would be managed behind the scenes by high school students, in partnership with District social workers.







