The District's 2024 Caucus will be held **Tuesday**, **February 6**, **2024** at Westside High School, 8701 Pacific Street. Caucus voter sign-in begins at 6:15 p.m.; the Caucus will begin at 7:00 p.m. We hope you will be able to attend!

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE CAUCUS?

A Caucus is held every two years to nominate up to four individuals for two positions on the Board of Education for Westside Community Schools. The names of up to four persons receiving the most votes at the Caucus will then be placed on the ballot for the statewide primary election on May 14, 2024, when two candidates will then be elected to the Board of Education for a six-year term.

WHEN CAN I VOTE?

There are **TWO** options available for voting:

- 1) **EARLY DAYTIME VOTING:** Daytime voting is available at Westside High School **from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** on Caucus Day February 6, 2024. **EARLY VOTING ENDS AT 6:00 p.m.**
- 2) AT THE CAUCUS: Ballots at the Caucus are accepted only AFTER all candidate speeches have concluded.

PLEASE NOTE!! If you are not able to wait until all candidates have spoken to submit your ballot at the caucus, please use the daytime voting option from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

WHO CAN VOTE AT THE CAUCUS?

You **must** be a registered voter residing in District 66 to vote at the Caucus. If you are not currently registered to vote, you must register at the **Douglas County Election Commission**, **12220 W. Center Road**, **Omaha**, **NE 68144 PRIOR to the Caucus**. Voter registration **is NOT** available at the Caucus.

INTERESTED IN RUNNING FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION?

Registered voters who reside in District 66 are eligible to run for the Board of Education and need to submit a written letter of intent to run, **no later than December 21, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.** to the attention of: Superintendent's Office, ABC Building, 909 S. 76th Street, Omaha, NE 68114. You must include your full legal name, address, and affirm your status as a registered voter. Eligibility is subject to verification through the Douglas County Election Commission.

For the candidate's name to appear pre-printed on the Caucus ballot and to be included in pre-Caucus press releases, letters of intent **MUST** be received by 4:00 p.m. on December 21, 2023.
