- Design Firms have been contracted for the first 5 projects.
- Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to design firms expected to go out Spring 2024 for Paddock Road Elementary, Rockbrook Elementary, and Westbrook Elementary Schools.







Current Projects Update:

Westgate Elementary

- Community meeting on 9-7-23 recap:
 - There is strong pride in the Westgate community.
 - Community meeting had ~ 40 community members in attendance.
 - Requests to keep mature trees, minimal impact to the mature trees is expected.
 - Parking and traffic are concerns for the community.
- Design Advisory Committee meetings recap:
 - Well attended, specifically by teachers
- Project Advocates discussed the current Omaha Parks community center attached to Westgate and working with the City to finalize the future plans for the center.
- The new Westgate will continue to house a food pantry, community closet, and transitional services spaces. These are in addition to the District Edspecs spaces.
- Project Advocates presented the Board-approved Westgate Conceptual Design.
- Project Advocates presented the mechanical systems design options.
- TACK Architects is planning to present the schematic design update to the BOE November 6, 2023.
- The Construction Manager at Risk (CMR) RFQ for Westgate is scheduled to be issued October 30, 2023.

Hillside Elementary

- Community meeting on 9-13-23 recap:
 - There is strong pride in the Hillside community.
 - Requests to keep mature trees, minimal impact to the mature trees is expected.
 - Concerns about projects being both equitable in both investment and quality.
- The new Hillside will potentially house a community planning space and health clinic. These are in addition to the District Edspecs spaces.
- Concept design package to be presented to the BOE October 17, 2023 for approval.

Westside Middle School

- Community meeting upcoming on 10-26-23.
- Previewed cafeteria expansion concept that will be presented to the BOE October 17, 2023 for approval.
- Discussed the current boiler system is need of replacement.

Westside ABC Building

- The concept design has progressed by BCDM and will be presented to the DAC in the coming weeks.
- Primary objective is improving accessibility.







Westside High School

- The first two summers will work on bathrooms, following summers work will be on the locker rooms and cafeteria expansion.
- Coordinating timing with the Foundation's project is key to limit the amount of time the pool, athletic entrance, and locker rooms are unavailable.

Bond Status:

• The first bond tranche was issued (par \$47.69M), summary report reviewed.
