

Community Club - October 13th, 2020

- Principal's Report
 - Nov 4th and Dec 9th are E-Learning days
 - Will be starting 5 days a week starting the week of October 19th
 - I Love Public Schools video should be out shortly
 - Halloween parties will be organized and put on by the teachers; no parents will be allowed to attend. Will be looking for ideas or help purchasing items from the Community Club (to be discussed later in the meeting)
- Treasurer's Report
 - Provide overview on balance and deposits
 - Current balance is \$5427.84
 - there are still 7 teacher reimbursement checks outstanding totalling \$525. Will give through the end of the calendar year before reaching out to the teachers, reminding them to cash the checks.
 - 402 BBQ said the amount donated is \$31 (10% of mentioned sales)
 - Update: Scooter's check was in the mail after the meeting concluded - check in the amount of \$125.75 (30% of sales) plus an additional \$20 donation from a customer
- Liability Insurance:
 - Individual CC insurance policies will not be required this year as we are covered as a rider under the Westside Community Schools policy.
- Old Business
 - Gaga pit
 - Ken stated he ordered and has the corner brackets on hand. Will need to purchase the lumber and hardware this spring when ready to go.
 - Amanda mentioned that Paddock Road had installed a gaga pit this fall
- New Business
 - Fundraising
 - Gator Gear water bottles
 - Provide three options and price points; plastic water bottle, 20 oz tumbler, 32 oz bottle with flip up straw lid
 - Amanda to start a Google form and make the CC members as collaborators.
 - Provide paypal link
 - Option for personalization on the two stainless steel cups (click yes/no and field to enter the name)
 - Place for pictures of the water bottles

- A place to note if this is a gift and shouldn't be sent home with their child.
 - Pop - Day of Awesomeness
 - Prairie Lane has one week left on their fundraiser and they are already at \$18,900
 - Decided on moving forward with the Pop fundraiser this fall and having the Day of Awesomeness in the spring.
 - Plan to have the kick off the week of Nov 16th; this allows the fundraising window to extend over Thanksgiving and hopefully boost the family giving.
 - Plan for the Read-a-Thon in the spring to coincide with One Book One School/Book Fair
 - Look into an online logging and fundraising program (will likely have a percentage fee)
 - Wait and see how covid plays out, but discuss and consider carnival and/or fun run at a later date.
- Student engagement activities
 - Fall party
 - Cookies provided by the school
 - Brooke to set up a Sign up Genius to send out to parents. Looking for juice box and skittles donations
 - CC to fill in the gaps plus provide bags, candy and trinkets. Teacher helpers and CC to work together to assemble the bags.

 - Popcorn and snacks
 - Order pizza that day

 - Possibly have a 6th grade group a teacher leader and a parent leader
 - 6th graders could do the cover with a competition; they could do the other 'fun' pages such as the community club events or the E-learning page, etc.
 - Amanda to reach out to see if any teachers are interested. Also reach out to some potential 1st or 2nd grade parents.
