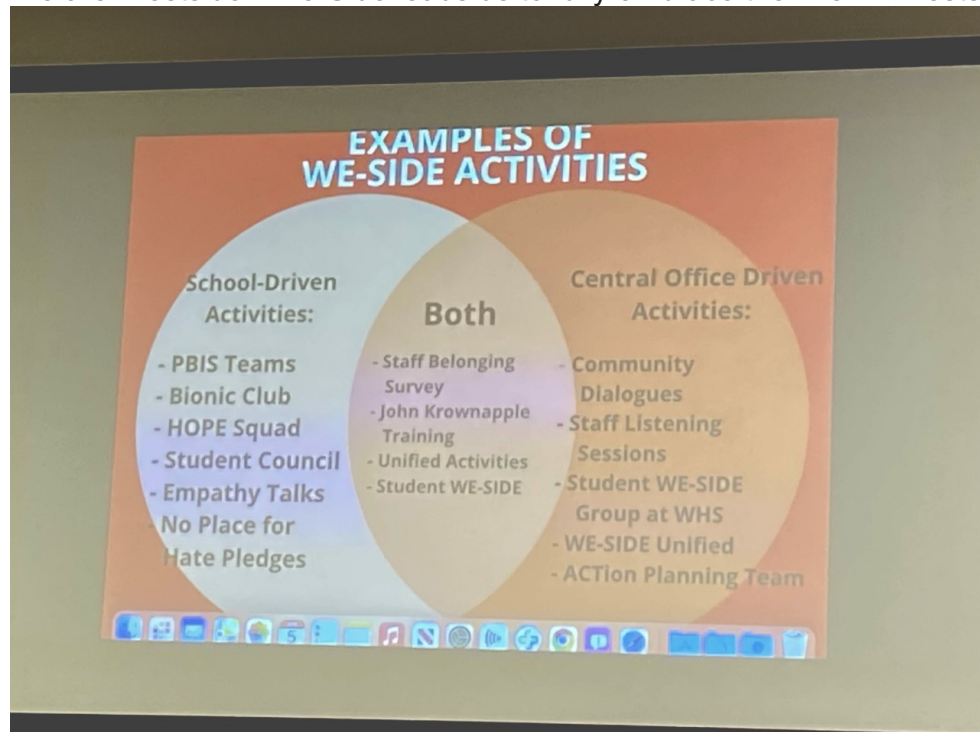


# Community Club - April 5th, 2022
