Who should attend the Metro Community College General Education Academy?

Students looking to get a head start on college coursework by earning high school and college credit at the same time. MCC tuition is reduced by 50% for high school students. Students must commit to the General Education Academy for the entire year.

What is the MCC General Education Academy?

A year of Metro Community College courses taken at Westside West Campus that helps give high school students a jump start on their two or four-year college degree. The objective is to provide students a successful, low-cost experience that will help them develop the skills necessary to successfully transition to a two or four-year college.

What is a typical day?

Students will be at Westside High School in the morning and transition to West Campus Mods 10/11-14, Monday-Thursday. Classes meet from 1:00-2:45 pm

- Fall quarter: English Composition I, American National Government
- Winter quarter: English Composition II, Statistics
- Spring quarter: Public Speaking, Intro to Psychology

LOCATION: Westside West Campus

TIME: Daily Monday-Thursday, 1:00-2:45 pm

PREREQUISITES: ACT English score of 18 or passing score on Metro writing placement exam; ACT math score of 20 or C's or higher in Algebra, Geometry and Advanced Algebra.

CREDIT OPTIONS: High school elective and core credits; transferable college credits

COST: Academy students benefit from a 50% discount on college tuition. For 2021-22, this was about \$350 each quarter. Students qualifying for Free/Reduced lunch should inquire with their counselor about the ACE scholarship.

GRADE LEVEL: Seniors, Juniors meeting academic requirements
