Accepting Feedback:

- 1. Look at the person.
- 2. Say "Okay."
- 3. Don't argue.

We explain Accepting Feedback in terms of a growth mindset.

When you accept another's feedback, people will see you as wanting to improve yourself. You will be thought of as mature, and others may want to work with you. You can also learn from your mistakes.
