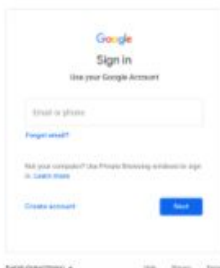
















The meeting notes from the September meeting were approved. There was no meeting in October.

Updates:

- No upcoming in-person events
- Directory—in progress
- Step-It-Up
  - \$10,661.60 profit
  - This will help the Community Club to distribute teacher stipends this year
  - Prairie Lane is the first school in the district to try this fundraiser; because it has been so successful, other schools are considering it.
  - Day of Awesomeness still tentatively planned for spring
  - Recommendation for next time: work on clearly communicating tiers, rewards, and expectations for students/families (what do you have to do to earn \_\_\_ prize?).
- T-Shirts
  - \$514 profit
  - hoodies were popular but not very profitable this year
- School Updates
  - School will be at 50% capacity for the next 3 weeks
  - Status after 3 weeks is undecided at this time
  - District is asking students and their families to wear masks while out in public, practice social distancing, etc.
- Volunteer Opportunities
  - Bingo—this may happen virtually this year; some other schools are planning that, so we will wait and see how this goes for them.
  - Read-A-Thon:

    - This involves creating a theme to make this a fun event for the kids. In previous years, this was an all-school assembly; this year, it may be a virtual event.
