Board of Education Meeting and Student Fees Public Hearing ~ April 24, 2023

The Board of Education of School District 66 was convened in an open and public session on April 24, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at the District Administration Office - ABC Building - 909 S. 76th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the meeting was given by placing advance notice on the front page of the District's website no less than 48 hours in advance of the scheduled commencement of the meeting as authorized by Board Policy 1220. Notice for this meeting appeared beginning on April 11, 2023, and appeared continuously up through the start of this board meeting. Notice of the meeting was also published in the Daily Record on April 21 and 24, 2023, and on their website. Copies of proof of publication are attached to the official minutes. Notice of this meeting and the availability of the agenda was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Education and available to anyone at the Board of Education office. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Dr. Van Gelder called the Board of Education Meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. She welcomed those in attendance and confirmed with Ms. Hurley that public notice had been given of the meeting under the Nebraska Open Meetings Act and that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was posted at the meeting and on the district website, as required by law. She acknowledged that the meeting had been publicly announced and the agenda was available to any interested parties. Board member attendance is noted above. Dr. Van Gelder requested a motion for an excused absence for Doug Krenzer. Ms. Karnes moved for approval; Ms. Morrissette seconded. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. (Mr. Yale arrived a few minutes late).

Student Fees Public Hearing

Dr. Van Gelder advised those in attendance that the Public Hearing is to hear opposition, support and observations regarding Student Fees for the 2023-2024 School Year, and that any resolution setting, altering or amending the Student Fees Policy (#6340) as a result of the hearing will be in accordance with Nebraska Revised Statutes, Section 79-2,125 through 2,134. Mr. Brain Gabrial, District Officer of Business and Finance, reviewed Policy 6340 and highlighted a few of the proposed changes for the 2023-2024 school year:

- Increases to some Summer Sports Camps for Elementary, Middle and High School
- Increases to transportation (bus service) for the Middle and High School
- Lunch Service (Elementary and Middle School: increase of \$.05) (High School: increase of \$.10)
- Increases to some extracurricular fees at both the Middle and High School
- Removal of the option for "Off-Campus" Parking fees at the High School

Revisions to Student Fees for 2023-2024 will be presented again for approval at the Board of Education Meeting on May 15, 2023. Mr. Yale moved for approval; Ms. Morrissette seconded. Motion carried by roll call vote.

Communications

Ms. Brandi Paul, Director of Communications and Community Engagement, advised the Board that regular communications continue to be sent to all families regarding the Phase II Bond Informational Meetings that are being held at various school buildings through May 3rd. News releases from the Douglas County Election Commission regarding voter registration and ballot deadlines are posted on the District website.

Personnel Report

Dr. Andrea Haynes, Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources and District Operations, presented the personnel report (five certified staff probationary contracts; two administrator resignations; one certified staff resignation; one administrator contract) for board approval. Mr. Yale moved for approval; Ms. Karnes seconded. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. A copy of the Personnel Report is included in the board documents folder.

Board Policy Revision for Approval

Mr. Nick Lesiak, In-House Legal Counsel, presented a revision to Policy #4380 for board approval. Previously presented for discussion and consideration at the April 10, 2023, Board Meeting, this revision will add Martin Luther King, Jr. Day as a paid holiday. Mr. Yale moved for approval; Ms. Morrissette seconded. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Copies of the Executive Summary and Policy #4380 are included in the board documents folder.

Public Comment

There were no requests for Public Comment.

Board Member Representation / Legislative Updates

Board members were represented at a number of events over the past two weeks including Phase II Bond Meetings at Westside Middle School (4/11 & 4/18)); Westbrook (4/13 & 4/23); Paddock Road (4/16); Hillside (4/16); Westgate (4/17); Loveland (4/20); and Rockbrook (4/23); Warrior Choir Competition; and the Multicultural Fair: "Taste of Westside" held on Saturday, April 22nd. Dr. Lucas shared that LB385 (Educator Recruitment and Retention bill) that the district supported continues to advance and could likely be attached to a "Christmas Tree" bill encompassing a number of other amended bills. He advised that our district lobbyist, Sean Kelley, continues to keep him and the Board informed of daily legislative activities.


