Board of Education FY23 Budget Public Hearing Minutes ~ September 6, 2022

A public hearing on the 2022-2023 budget for Westside Community Schools was held in open and public session on September 6, 2022, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the District Administration Office - ABC Building - 909 S. 76th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of this budget hearing and required information was given by publishing advance notice in *The Daily Record* in Omaha, Nebraska prior to the hearing (August 29-31; September 1-2 and 5-6, 2022), confirmation of which is attached to the official minutes. Advance notice also appeared on the front page of the District's website beginning on August 16, 2022, and appeared continuously up through the start of this public hearing, a copy of which is attached to the official minutes, as authorized by Board Policy 1220. Notice of this meeting and the availability of the agenda was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Education and available to anyone at the Board of Education office. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

At 6:03 p.m. Dr. Van Gelder called the public hearing to order. Board member roll call was taken and attendance is noted above. Dr. Van Gelder welcomed the audience and confirmed with Ms. Hurley that public notice had been given of the meeting under the Nebraska Open Meetings Act and that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was posted at the meeting, as required by law. She acknowledged that the meeting had been publicly announced and the agenda was available to any interested parties.

Purpose of Hearing

Dr. Van Gelder announced that the purpose of the public hearing is to hear support, opposition, or observations relating to the proposed budgets for School District 66 for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. Mr. Brian Gabrial, District Officer of Business and Finance, reviewed expected budget expenditures for both levy and non-levy funds for FY23.

Levy Funds:

FY23 levy fund amounts: General fund - \$95,768,577; Employee Benefits fund - \$200,002; Bond Debt Service fund - \$6,673,885; and Special Building fund - \$2,230,801. The total for levy funds for FY23 is \$104,873,265. This is an increase of \$4,876,719 (4.88%) from the FY22 amended budget of \$99,996,546 for total levy funds.

Non-Levy Funds:

FY23 non-levy fund amounts: Nutrition Services - \$7,088,657; Activities - \$2,000,000; Enterprise -\$526,530; and Student Fees - \$250,000. The total for non-levy funds for FY23 is \$9,865,187. This is a decrease of \$25,130 (0.25%) from the FY22 budget of \$9,890,317 for total non-levy funds.

Dr. Lucas stressed that, even with an increase to the General Fund Reserves and a reduction in the tax levy rate for the fourth year in a row, District leadership and the Board of Education do not take these positives for granted. They will continue to make wise and thoughtful decisions that balance the needs of taxpayers and the district. The Public Hearing on the proposed property tax levy will be held at 6:00 p.m. on September 19, 2022, prior to the Board of Education Meeting. The board vote to adopt the FY22 budget will occur at the September 19, 2022, Board of Education Meeting. The budget is due to the state auditor, the county clerk and NDE on September 30, 2022. Copies of Mr. Gabrial's Executive Summary, PowerPoint and the State of Nebraska Budget Form are included in the public hearing documents folder. The public hearing was adjourned at 6:19 p.m.
