Board of Education Meeting ~ November 21, 2022

The Board of Education of School District 66 was convened in an open and public session on November 21, 2022, at 12:00 Noon at the District Administration Office - ABC Building - 909 S. 76th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the meeting was given by placing advance notice on the front page of the District's website no less than 48 hours in advance of the scheduled commencement of the meeting as authorized by Board Policy 1220. Notice for this meeting appeared beginning on November 8, 2022, and appeared continuously up through the start of this board meeting. Notice of the meeting was also published in the Daily Record on November 18 and 21, and on their website. Copies of proof of publication are attached to the official minutes. Notice of this meeting and the availability of the agenda was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Education and available to anyone at the Board of Education office. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Dr. Van Gelder called the Board of Education Meeting to order at 12:00 Noon. She welcomed those in attendance and confirmed with Ms. Hurley that public notice had been given of the meeting under the Nebraska Open Meetings Act and that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was posted at the meeting and on the district website, as required by law. She acknowledged that the meeting had been publicly announced and the agenda was available to any interested parties. Board member attendance is noted above. Dr. Van Gelder requested a motion for an excused absence for Doug Krenzer and Beth Morrissette. Mr. Yale moved for approval; Ms. Blakely seconded. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Annual District Audit Report

Mr. Jess Paisley of Eide Bailly LLP presented the annual district audit report. He thanked Brian Gabrial, District Officer of Business and Finance, and his staff for their responsiveness and assistance in handling all of the requests for information that were made during the audit process this year. As last year, a great deal of the audit work was completed remotely. Prior to today's presentation to the full Board, Mr. Paisley held a post-audit review meeting with the Board Finance Committee (Dr. Van Gelder, Ms. Blakely and Mr. Yale) on October 27, 2022, to discuss the audit findings. Mr. Paisley advised the Board that Eide Bailly acquired Seim Johnson in July 2022, a move that was beneficial to Seim Johnson staff and partners. Mr. Paisley highlighted a couple of audit findings that included corrected statements from last year reclassification of accounts to record receipts; and a new entry for Foundation reimbursement for capital projects - neither of which impacted the fund balance. There were outstanding cash disbursements to activity funds totaling \$153,000, though Mr. Paisley had no concerns and was confident that these funds would be recovered with checks that had not cleared as of the end of August (end of the budget fiscal year). Mr. Paisley praised the District's continued vigilance in utilizing tax-payer dollars and effective budgeting, which resulted in an 18% increase to the General Fund Balance. Copies of the Audit Report and Mr. Paisley's keynote presentation are included in the board meeting documents folder.

Board Policy for Review

Dr. Lucas presented proposed revisions to Policy #7250 (Distribution of Materials from Outside Organizations) for consideration and discussion by the Board. These revisions will provide the District more flexibility in permitting materials that provide a benefit to students, staff, and families. This policy will be presented for approval at the Board of Education Meeting on December 12, 2022. A redline copy of policy 7250 and the Executive Summary are included in the board documents folder.

Sale of District Equipment

Mr. Russ Olsen, Director of Facilities, requested board approval for the sale of a timpani drum from Westside Middle School. Mr. Yale moved for approval; Ms. Karnes seconded. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. A copy of the Executive Summary is included in the board documents folder.

Public Comment: There were no requests for public comment.
