Build A Hut is back! This award-winning STEM summer camp and competition serves youth entering 6-8th grade. Youth will progress through a series of hands-on activities that will build their skillset in three major branches of engineering: construction, energy and civil!

Upon completion of the camp experience, selected participants will compete with other teams to first survive, then thrive in the community of their African village, New Maiwut! Competition teams will work with local engineering sponsors to build a hut using off-grid technology to produce energy for power and water transportation.
